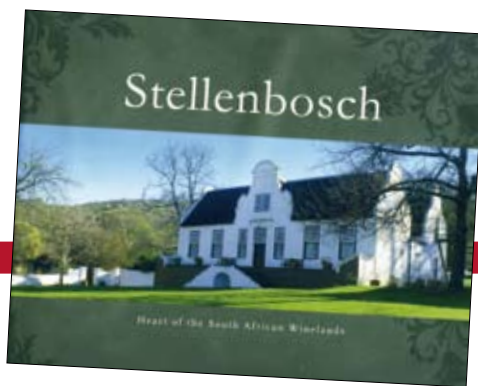
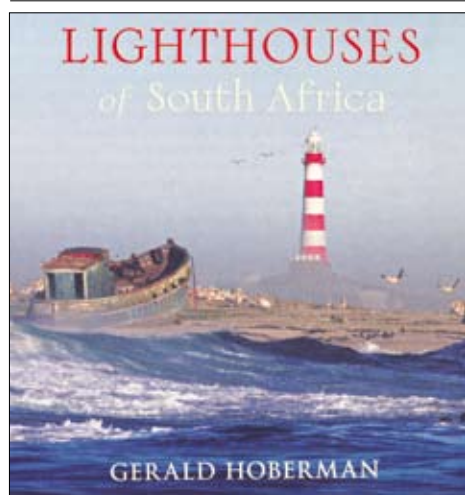

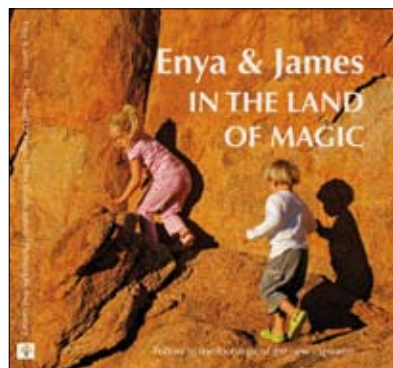

Tales of the Karoo

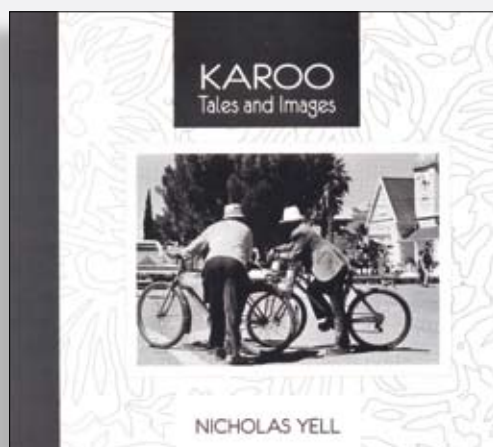
